

WHEN SHOULD YOU RENEW?




- Many countries require 6 months' validity on your current passport.
- Avoid stress and expense by renewing early.
- Processing time
 - 6 8 weeks Routine
 - 2-3 weeks Expedited

WHAT WILL YOU NEED TO RENEW?



- Application (DS-82)
- Passport (<15 years old)
- Photo (<6 months old)
- Fee (check or money order)



PICTURE-PERFECT PHOTO REQUIREMENTS

Already Have a Photo?

Use our photo cropping tool to correctly size your photo. No glasses allowed.



START PHOTO TOOL

- One photo must be attached to the application; it must:
 - Be less than 6 months old
 - Use a plain/off-white background
 - Be printed in color on matte or glossy photo-quality paper
 - Be 2 x 2 inches (51 x 51 mm)
- You cannot:
 - Wear glasses, face mask, hat or head covering, headphones or other hands-free devices

PUTTING IT ALL TOGETHER

- Enclose the completed application with the photo stapled to it in a large envelope.
 Do not fold the application.
- Enclose a personal check or money order payable to U.S. Department of State.
 - \$110 Passport Book
 - \$30 Passport Card
 - \$140 Book and Card
- Expedited service is available for an additional \$60.
- 1 2-day delivery of an expedited passport book is an additional \$17.13.

All fees are non-refundable.

READY TO MAIL?

Do not use any carrier but the U.S. post office or Canada Post **and** use a trackable delivery method such as:

- USPS Priority Mail
- USPS Express Mail
- Canada Post Track

Certified and Registered mail **are** trackable, **but may take longer to deliver.**

READY TO MAIL?

Mail your envelope to one of the following addresses.

- If you live in CA, FL, IL, MN, NY or TX: National Passport Processing Center Post Office Box 640155 Irving, TX 75064-0155
- If you live in any other state, territory or Canada: National Passport Processing Center Post Office Box 90155 Philadelphia, PA 19190-0155
- For Expedited Service (an additional fee applies). Write "EXPEDITE" on the outside of the mailing envelope and mail to: National Passport Processing Center Post Office Box 90955 Philadelphia, PA 19190-0955

Important Renewal Exceptions

You cannot renew by mail if:

- Your most recent passport is more than 15 years old
- You live outside the U.S. or Canada (U.S. territory residents can renew by mail)
- Your most recent passport is damaged other than normal wear and tear
- You cannot document your name change (an original or certified copy of your marriage certificate, divorce decree, or court order is valid documentation)
- Your most recent passport was issued before your 16th birthday

LINKS & ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Frequent travelers may request a larger, 52-page book at no additional cost.

U.S. citizens residing outside the 50 states, District of Columbia, U.S. territories or Canada must renew at a passport center.
